School Uniform Changes

Earlier in the year you may remember filling in a survey regarding our current uniform. At this stage we are not making great changes and if this is to happen in the future it will be done over a staggered period of time. Looking at the feedback which was collected from parents, students and staff we have decided to act on a couple of matters. Effective immediately the following changes will now be acceptable. Boys and girls can now wear **plain white** socks with their uniform, the grey and green socks will be phased out at the beginning of next year. Girls wanting to wear shorts can now wear the green shorts instead of the grey shorts. Boys are still to wear the grey shorts unless it is a sports day. Girls and boys can now wear **all black** school shoes or runners as part of the uniform. Please note black shoes/runners with any other colour are not to be worn. They must be completely black including the sole of the shoe.

Please ensure all fees are up to date before the end of term.


